Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) is seeking expressions of interest from suitable qualified candidates for **two** positions as Associate Vice-President, Medicine, Quality & Safety, VCH.

Overview

Reporting to the Vice President, Medicine, Quality & Safety, Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH), the Associate Vice Presidents assume joint accountability for providing senior executive leadership to the following areas:

- Quality, Safety and Risk
- Medical Administration/Medical Affairs
- Academic/Research
- Regional Programs/Medical Leadership

Together with the Vice President, the Associate Vice Presidents are responsible and accountable for the organization's medical staff with respect to bylaws, credentialing, the appointment and re-appointment of medical staff and represent VCH in issues involving the College of Physicians and Surgeons and Professional Medical Associations. Under the direction of the Vice President, the Associate Vice Presidents will chair key physician and clinical committees aimed at both alignment of programs, integration of standards of care and driving continuous improvement.

With respect to Quality and Safety, the Associate Vice Presidents together with the Vice President, are responsible to provide leadership and direction to ensure the delivery of quality services in a variety of health areas, and ensure the direction of human, financial and material resources of the portfolio to support the goals, policies and visions of the organization. Under the direction of the Vice President, the Associate Vice Presidents will participate on various VCH Advisory committees and collaborate with senior leadership from other health authorities to implement province-wide systems that look to the renewal of current practices to prevent, identify and resolve patient safety and quality issues. The Associate Vice Presidents will also develop and maintain close links with various health services in order to share expertise, review processes, and provide input into the delivery of health care to ensure integrated systems as well as represent the Health Authority's interests by initiating and developing cooperative relationships with the Ministry of Health, community agencies, organizations and stakeholders of VCH.

Remuneration

Remuneration for these positions, paid as stipends, will be commensurate with experience and the agreed upon administrative time commitment.

Qualifications

Licensed physician in the Province of British Columbia. A level of education, training and experience equivalent to a Master's preparation in Health, Business Administration or related health discipline, plus ten (10) years' practice and senior management experience in a medium to large sized, complex health care organization.
