One Uveitis and Medical Retina Specialist

The successful candidate will be required to run a weekly Resident Uveitis Teaching Clinic at St. Paul's Hospital (SPH), and to provide a leadership role in Resident Teaching in the operating room at Mount St. Joseph's (MSJ) Hospital. They will provide medical and surgical comprehensive ophthalmology call services as part of the PHC Ophthalmology call group.

The successful candidate will be eligible for a Clinical Faculty appointment in the Department of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences, Faculty of Medicine, at the University of British Columbia. He or she will be appointed to the medical staff at SPH and MSJ in the department of ophthalmology.

Candidates must hold or be eligible for certification by the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada in Ophthalmology, and be eligible for licensing or licensed in good standing in British Columbia. The successful candidate must have one year of uveitis fellowship training and one year of medical retina fellowship training. PHC seeks a candidate with a proven track record of publication in peer reviewed journals and the ability to take a leadership role in the formal uveitis and retina teaching curriculum at UBC.

PHC is a merit base organization and is committed to employment equality. Canadians and permanent residents of Canada will be given priority. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted.
